

The WD-100 is a water detector incorporating microchip technology and gold-plated electrodes. This device can be operated from either an AC or DC supply and has a built-in fail-safe mechanism. The output of the detector is a reverse acting form "C" relay contact capable of switching 5 Amps at 250 Vac.

Fail-safe circuitry is incorporated in the WD-100 to signal an alarm condition in the event of a power loss or internal malfunction. This offers maximum security of the monitoring system.

The device is also available with a remote probe assembly.

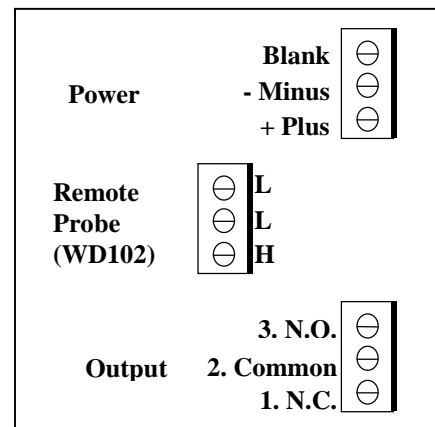
